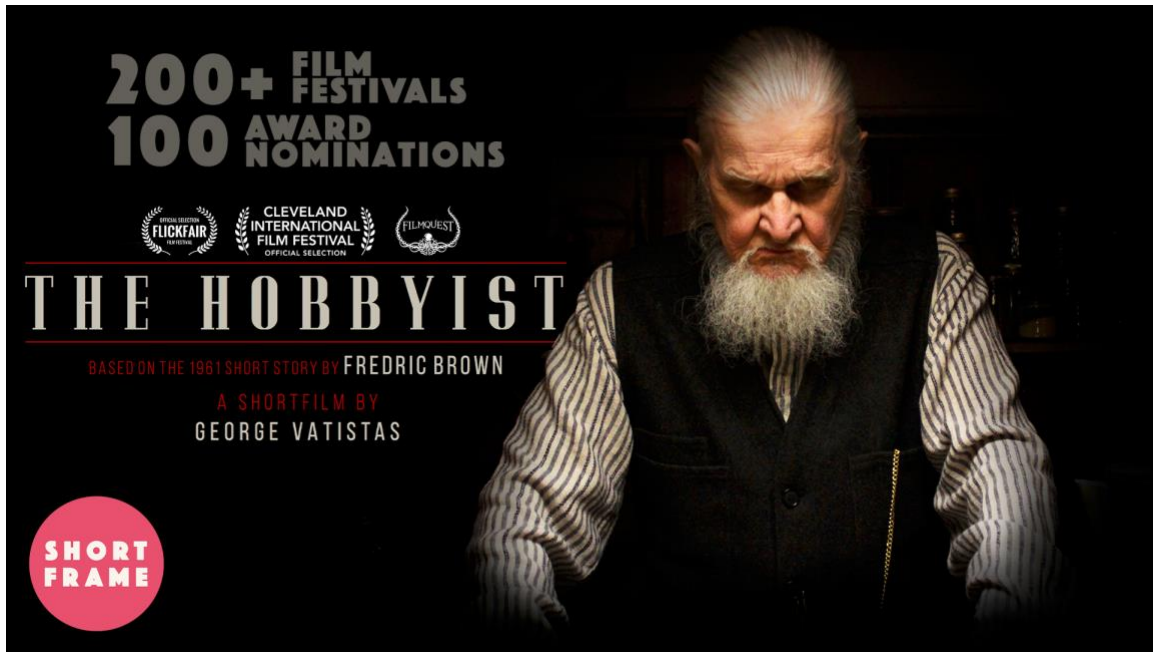

“The Hobbyist” is based on the 1961 Short Story by the same title written by Fredric Brown.

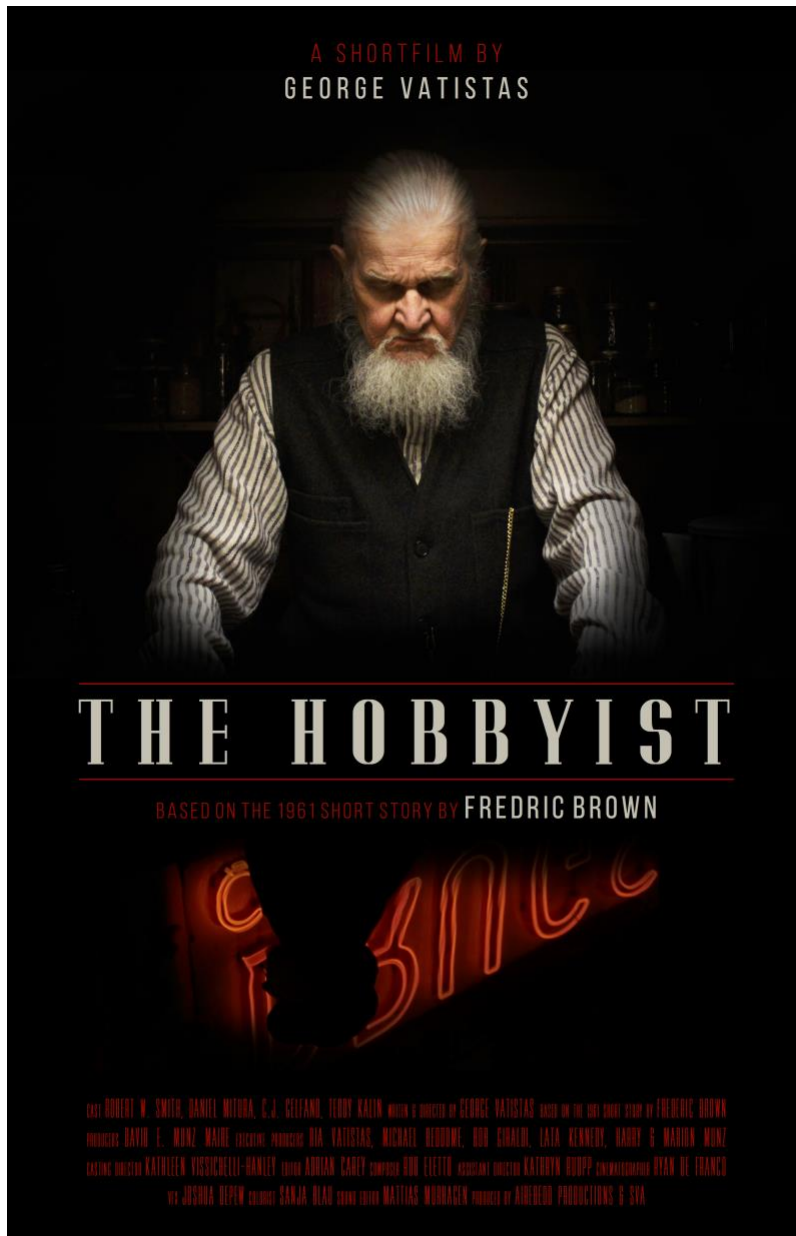
“The Hobbyist” was shot in the East Village, Lower East Side and Flatbush neighborhoods of New York City over two and a half days in 2016. It was filmed on the Arri Alexa with Anamorphic lenses to achieve a textured, vintage aesthetic.

“The Hobbyist” was edited using Adobe Premiere Pro and finally completed in early 2017.

“The Hobbyist” is the second short film written and directed by George Vatisas.

“The Hobbyist” is George Vatisas’ graduate thesis film at the School of Visual Arts’ Live Action Short Film Masters program, of which David M. Night Maire is also an alumnus.
