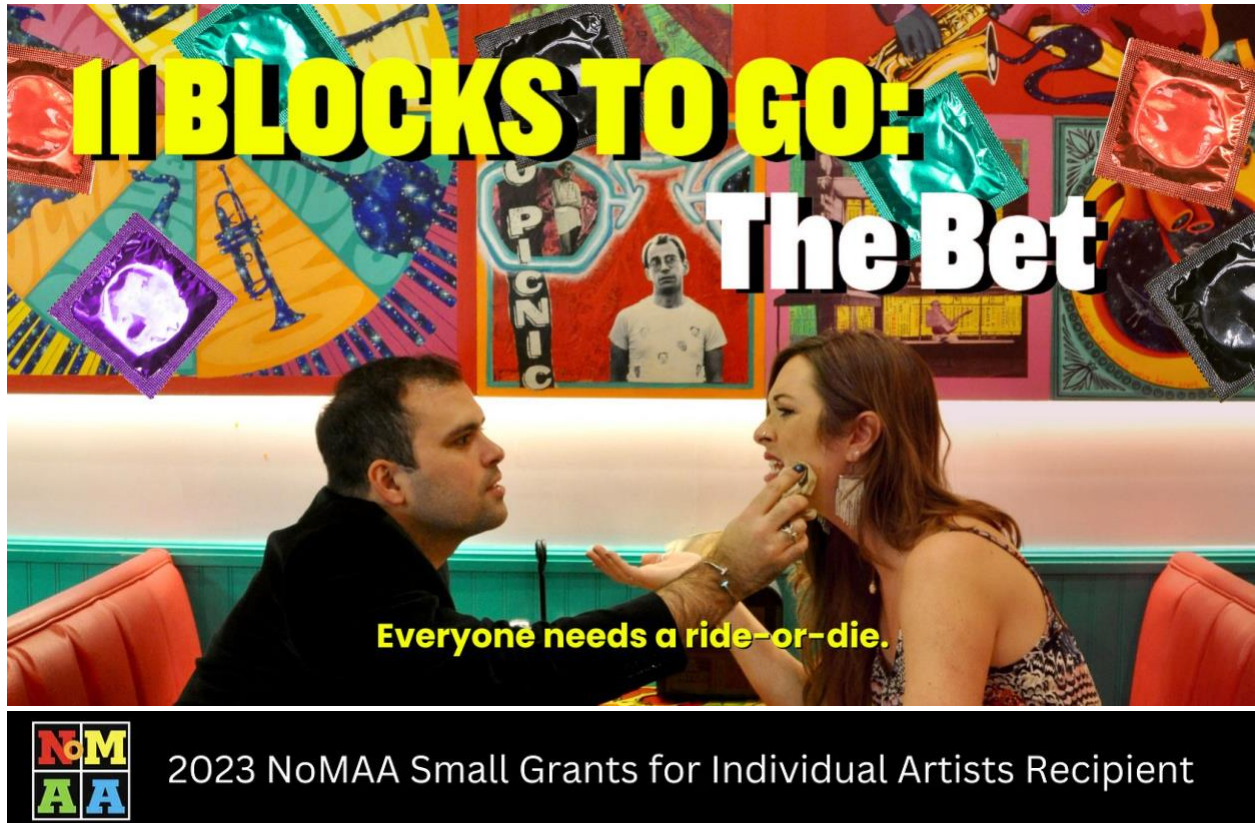

**LOGLINE**

Samantha, a free-spirited hopeless romantic, discovers her 30-something-year-old BFF Drew, a gay high-functioning drug-addled sex addict, is hosting an orgy in lieu of honoring his personal commitments.

**SHORT SYNOPSIS**

Old flames Gray and Samantha track down their no-show mutual bestie, Drew, to his apartment, only to find him hosting an orgy in lieu of honoring his personal commitments. Tensions rise when Drew and Samantha confront each other's concerning choices, leading them to make a transformative bet.

**LONG SYNOPSIS**

Drew, a gay high-functioning drug-addled sex addict, hosts an orgy in lieu of honoring his personal commitments with best friends Samantha, a free-spirited wild child, and Gray, her old flame. Samantha has Gray help her track down Drew after his no-show and confronts his lack of consideration. While confronting Drew about his use of drugs and sex to avoid getting over a year-old breakup, Drew calls Samantha on her own avoidance, i.e., her hidden feelings for Gray. The evening comes to a head when Samantha and Drew, having never turned down a bet, agree to a mutual challenge of self-betterment. Samantha will focus on what she wants in life, and Drew will focus on only what he needs, making amends with his ex-boyfriend Henri.

## **ABOUT THE PRODUCTION**

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” is a proof-of-concept pilot for a series project titled “11 Blocks to Go.”

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” was originally written as episode 3 for season 1 of the “11 Blocks to Go” series.

"11 Blocks To Go: The Bet" was a NoMAA Small Grants for Individual Artists Recipient, which provided the backing to produce the pilot/ film.

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” was shot on location in Jack Utrata and director Nathaniel P. Claridad’s Washington Heights apartment in New York City.

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” was filmed on a Blackmagic 6k camera over the course of two days and edited in Adobe Premier Pro.

Co-creators Ashley Alexander and Jack Utrata met at a bar in Hell’s Kitchen in NYC, became fast friends, and signed up for improv together which led to their writing partnership.

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” is director Nathaniel P. Claridad’s directorial film debut.

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” is the first film collaboration between director Nathaniel P. Claridad and co-creator Ashley Alexander.

“11 Blocks to Go: The Bet” director Nathaniel P. Claridad and co-creator Jack Utrata first met and collaborated in 2013 at The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Director Nathaniel P. Claridad and co-creator Jack Utrata previously collaborated on the award-winning 2020 film “Shakespeare in Quarantine” film.

In 2021, co-creator Jack Utrata directed director Nathaniel P. Claridad in “Sonnet #154” for The New York Shakespeare Exchange sonnet project.

Co-creator Jack Utrata and director Nathaniel P. Claridad are husbands. They married in 2022.

## WRITERS' STATEMENTS

11 Blocks was born out of the love Ashley and I have for one another. We met in December 2018 and shortly after took improv together at The PIT in NYC, and our friendship escalated FAST. We latched onto one another, laugh after laugh and knew that after class was through, our story was only just beginning. I had been told my whole life that I should write, but I never knew what form that would take or how to start. I knew it would be far less intimidating if I had a partner with whom to take on the creative world. And so we started writing using prompts, and after two rounds of that, we found something that slightly resembled alternate versions of ourselves, these loveable fools who took slightly more outlandish risks than us but possessed all of our heart, and the process quickly consumed us. The greater vision for this story is to honor platonic love between best friends in a television series that explores the extreme boundaries of what a friendship can and should be. We hope to find an audience who see themselves reflected back in this queer, feminist family of characters and who experience the joy that we have in creating them.

### **-Jack Utrata**

My ever quickly growing close friendship with Jack is what laid the foundation of our short. At the beginning of our friendship, we found an instant connection and unmatched chemistry that catapulted us into a deep desire to play and create together. 11 Blocks is essentially derived from an excuse for Jack and I to hang out and laugh more, however, it quickly became our passion project as we poured our hearts into these characters and discovered their platonic love story. Our writing sessions led us to deeper personal shares of our own real-life struggles and relatable challenges with “self,” and ultimately moved us to incorporate personal stories, quirks, and heartache to thicken our comedic characters’ lives and their backstories. As Jack and I experimented with weaving nuanced detail and these different dramatic plot lines into their lives, we knew our vision became the same when seeing how our characters loved each other in the face of messy truths and difficult choices. Their love and regard for one another highlights what I have found to be true: to have the partner in crime, the ride or die, the bestie-for-the-restie to see you through big decisions and everyday life is one of the best loves one can find. What started out as a lighthearted sketch comedy, morphed into a feature film, then a 3 season series, and finally our proof of concept short that we hope reaches audiences that crave a bestie love story and freedom for self-discovery.

Nathaniel P. Claridad is a director and actor based in New York City. Other film credits as a director include "Shakespeare in Quarantine," in collaboration with Jack Utrata, which won Best Film at the 2020 Katonah Classic Stage Film Festival. Nathaniel primarily directs for the stage, and his NYC and regional credits include work at Weathervane Theatre (where his production of "A Midsummer Night's Dream" was nominated for Best Play at the New Hampshire Theatre Awards), Imagination Stage, Southern Rep., TheatreWorksUSA, Two River Theatre, PlayMakers Repertory Company, and Out of the Box Theatrics. In addition he has also been named a Drama League Resident both in 2016 and 2019 and the 2024 Directing Fellow with New York City Center. He has also worked at New York University, Marymount Manhattan, and the University of Maryland, College Park as a guest director. He is also co-founder of Broadway Twisted, an annual event in North Carolina benefitting the North Carolina AIDS Action Network and BC/EFA. As an actor, Nathaniel's numerous credits include the original company of "Here Lies Love" at the Public Theater, and "Taylor Mac's 24-Decade History of Popular Music" at St. Ann's Warehouse (he also appears in the HBO documentary). 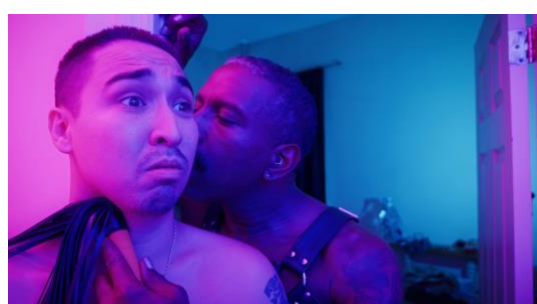
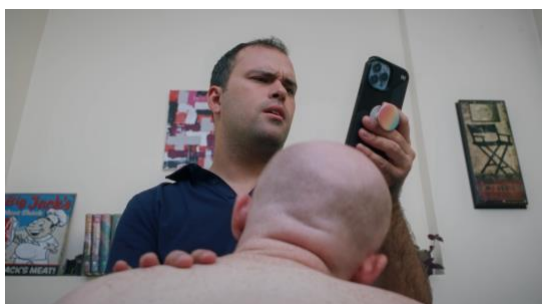
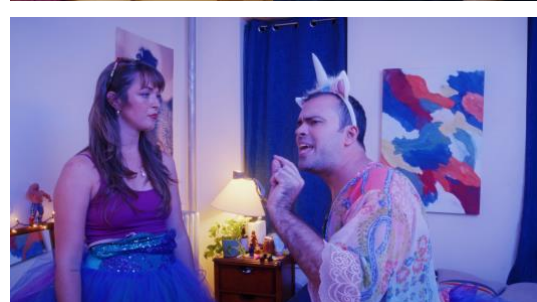
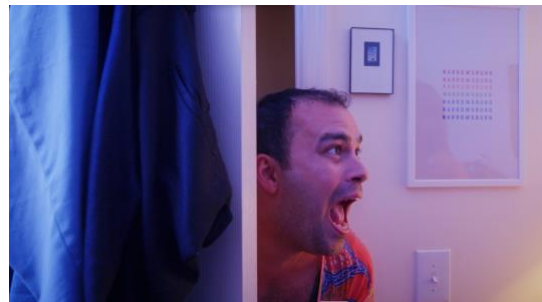
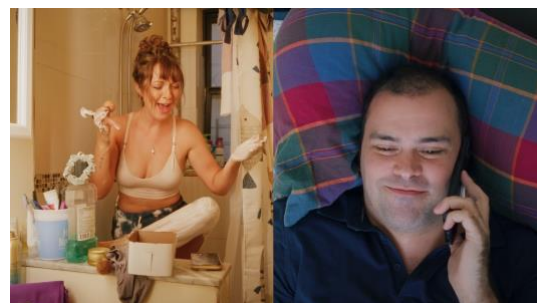
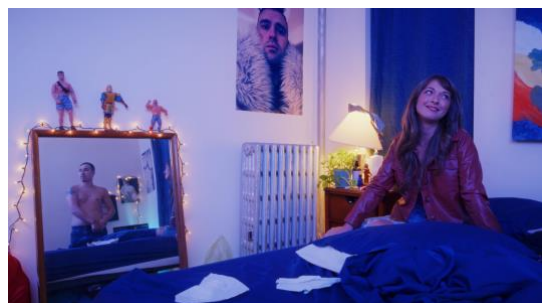
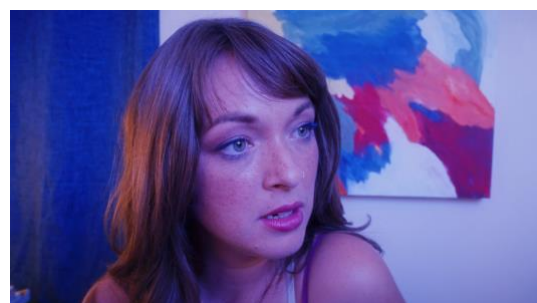
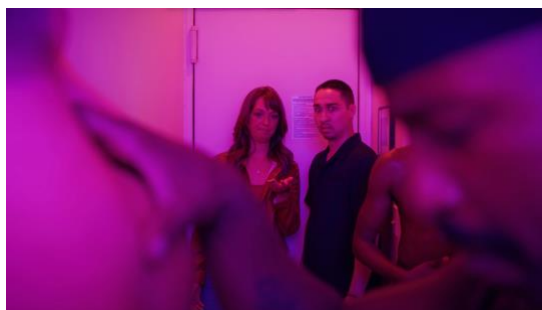
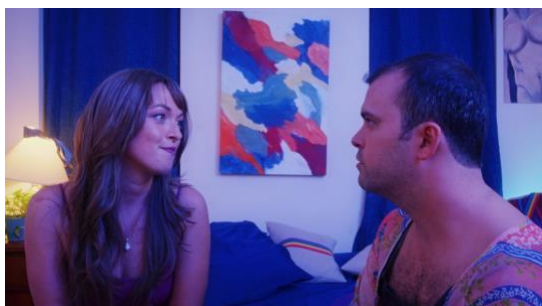
**DAVID. M. NIGHT MAIRE**

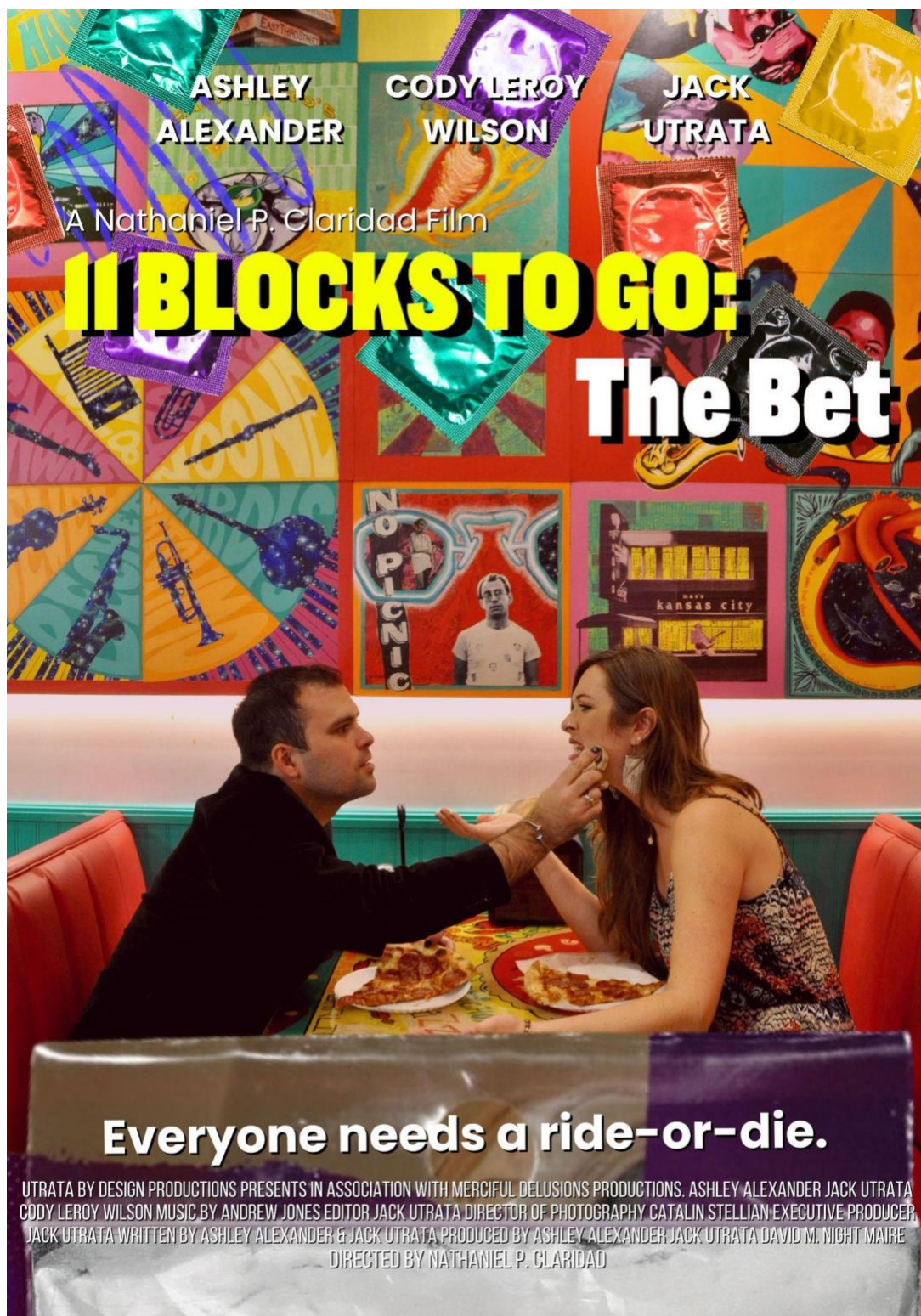

Great marketability - could see these being loved by teens and young adults particularly streaming or on tv. The comedic choice in dialogue has similar lingo to *Broad City* or *Shrill* in the way characters communicate with each other - it’s not universally relatable but a niche target drawn to “millennial/Gen-Z” culture.”
