SHORT SYNOPSIS – PILOT Episode 1 ‘A Star is Born’

Creatively frustrated Diana endures another soul-crushing day as an elite matchmaker. She listens to self-absorbed clients, survives a humiliating video call, and narrowly escapes being fired. At rock bottom, Diana convinces her talented friend Charlie to play the role of ‘William’ for a dream date with Ciara, her client-from-hell. At the breakneck speed of a farce, the pair navigate the date’s debacles and decide to expand the business.

LOGLINE - SERIES

An elite matchmaker creates a secret ‘dating ring’ pairing her 1%-er clients with out-of-work actors.

SHORT SYNOPSIS – SERIES

Ex-playwright turned elite matchmaker Diana is plagued by medical bills and on the brink of losing her job. Desperate, she uses her wealthy clients' lists of impossible romantic demands as casting breakdowns, hires her broke actor friends to portray these ‘dream dates,’ and inadvertently launches an underground empire.

SHORT OVERVIEW – SERIES

Ex-playwright-turned-elite-matchmaker Diana is plagued by medical bills and on the brink of losing her job. Desperate, she uses her wealthy clients' list of impossible romantic demands as casting breakdowns, hires her broke actor friends to portray these 'dream dates'... and inadvertently launches an underground empire. Initially vowing to work this dating scam only until her post-cancer medical bills are paid, our matchmaker soon struggles to get out of the game. Not only is the money good, but the actors are doing their best work in years! Diana will battle the suspicions of rival matchmakers, the egos of needy actors, and the unrealistic expectations of her 1% clients as she strives to turn a profit and stay out of jail.

ABOUT THE PRODUCTION

“MATCHED” is a proof-of-concept pilot for a series project titled “MATCHED”.

“MATCHED” was shot on location in New York City, NY and Jersey City, NJ over the course of 4 days and 1 overnight.

“MATCHED” is inspired by Creator- Writer- Exec. Producer- Actor Dominique Salerno's own experiences working as a professional Manhattan matchmaker to elite 1%-ers.

CREATOR-WRTIER'S STATEMENT

I'm excited to tell this story, because I lived this story- except for the fraud part, I promise!

I worked as an elite matchmaker for two years, and you wouldn't believe the things I did to find love for the 1%. The day I knew I had to quit was the day a bachelor asked me to grab my own boob to visualize his preferred cup size. That was a low.

Don't believe me? I was featured in The New York Times twice: once with a rave review for my solo show and once for my skills as a professional Manhattan matchmaker.

Working as both an artist and elite matchmaker, I was clued into two completely different social spheres simultaneously. While my artist friends struggled to feed themselves, my matchmaking clients overanalyzed their dates' cufflinks. These two jarringly different worlds created a hilarious disconnect in my life which inspired this series.

Elite matchmaking has high stakes involving love, desire, rejection, deception, and money. And the brutal truth of the matchmaking industry will knock your socks off.

Hurd starred in the crime drama *The Glades* (2010–2013), the comedy horror *Ash vs Evil Dead* (2016), and the crime drama *Blindspot* (2015–2018). She played Raffi Musiker in the science fiction series *Star Trek: Picard* (2020–2023) and achieved her highest-grossing film with the romantic comedy *Anyone but You* (2023). Hurd ran in 2025 for secretary-treasurer of SAG-AFTRA and was elected to a two-year term.

JASON KRAVITS

as Ralph

Jason began his career in Washington, DC, at age 13, playing Lolo in the short-lived but highly acclaimed PBS series *Powerhouse* (1982). After graduating from the University of Maryland, he found a home in the Washington, DC, theater community, where he became a well-known presence at theaters such as the Round House Theater, the Shakespeare Theater, and the Woolly Mammoth Theater Company. Upon moving to New York City, Jason began working with the writer-performer collective known as Rumble in the Red Room. There, alongside fellow writer-performer Joel Jones, he developed the material for "Making Faces," which would eventually go on to win Best Sketch Show at 1999's U.S. Comedy Festival in Aspen, Co. This prompted him to move to Los Angeles, where he soon landed a guest-star spot on David Kelley's *The Practice* (1997). This role would eventually grow and, by the beginning of the fifth season, his character, A.D.A Richard Bay, would be a regular on the show. (The character would eventually meet his demise in a hail of bullets on the show's 100th episode.) After several more busy years of television and film work, Jason would eventually move back to New York, although he remained busy on both coasts as both an actor and a writer. Jason Kravits is probably best known for his work on television dramas such as the *Law & Order* (1990) franchises. He has found just as much success in comedy, however, from his award-winning original sketch show "Making Faces" to noted roles on *Everybody Loves Raymond* (1996) and *Curb Your Enthusiasm* (2000).

Joy Franz is an American actress and singer. A native of Overland Park, Kansas, she graduated from the University of Missouri-Kansas City, majoring in music. She acted in the Starlight Theatre in Kansas City three summers before she moved to New York. She's best known for her stage work, for playing Susan in the original 1972 West End production of Stephen Sondheim's *Company*, and the role of Cinderella's Stepmother in the original 1987 Broadway production of Sondheim's *Into the Woods*. She was also in the ensemble of the 1965 New York City Center production of *Guys and Dolls*. She also appeared in the Broadway productions of *A Little Night Music* and *Pippin*, and the national tours of *Company*, *The Sound of Music*, *Guys and Dolls*, and *Damn Yankees*. She reprised her role of Cinderella's Stepmother in *Into the Woods* twice. First, in the 1988-90 US Tour, and then again in the 2002 Broadway revival. In the Broadway revival she also played Little Red's Granny and understudied the role of Jack's Mother. She was one of the Street Singers in the world premiere of Leonard Bernstein's *Mass* at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts on September 8, 1971. She most recently appeared as the Dowager Empress in US National Tour of *Anastasia* and portrays the role of the Mother in My Damn Channel's television series *Horrible People*.

After an initial career in architecture, she pivoted to comedy and filmmaking. She studied comedy and directing at Second City Film School. Her short DINGUS WISHES, placed in multiple film festivals and helped her secure the Viacom/Nickelodeon Directing Fellowship. Since completing the program, she's directed multiple episodes of JIMMY KIMMEL LIVE!, DANGER FORCE and FAIRLY ODDPARENTS. Her web series, WE'RE DOING GOOD!, premiered at SXSW, was nominated for a Webby and screened at HollyShorts, SeriesFest and BroadHumor where it won Best Series. She's a recipient of the Best Female Creator award from AMC Networks.
