LOG LINE

A troubled teen takes the babysitter hostage after she uncovers his deadly plan.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

Troubled teen Stanley rebukes babysitter Vicky's attempts to connect with him, until a slip of the finger ignites a torturous showdown that sees Vicky taken hostage after uncovering the adolescent's deadly plans.

LONG SYNOPSIS

Hired to house-sit for a family friend, Vicky spends an evening with Stanley, a standoffish teenager she babysat years prior. The troubled adolescent rebukes her every attempt to reconnect with him, despite seemingly warming up to a shared memory of the passing of his childhood pet bird. Yet, a slip of the finger ignites a cat-and-mouse like showdown, thrusting each of them into an undesirably torturous confrontation that has them fend the other off for their respective survival.

Half a year prior to receiving recommendations for the role of Vicky, Andrew J. Edison attended the Edinburgh Fringe Festival and saw McLean Peterson on stage as Ivanka Trump in Rachel Dart's "Ivanka Play"!

"Birdie" is Andrew J. Edison's NYU: Tisch School of the Arts thesis short film.

Sharad Kant Patel was also the Cinematographer of Andrew J. Edison's feature film "Bindlestiffs" (2012), and collaborated with him as Writer, Producer, Editor, and Visual FX Artist on a number of his previous short films.

"Birdie" was shot in New Hyde Park village, North Hemsptead township, Nassau County, Long Island, New York, United States over the course of four days.

"Birdie" was filmed on an Arri Alexa Mini camera with a package of Lomo Anamorphic round front lenses and edited in Adobe Premiere.

The replica handguns and assault weapons were rented from The Specialists Ltd., the East Coast's largest theatrical weapons property house.

"Birdie" is dedicated to Andrew J. Edison's cousin.

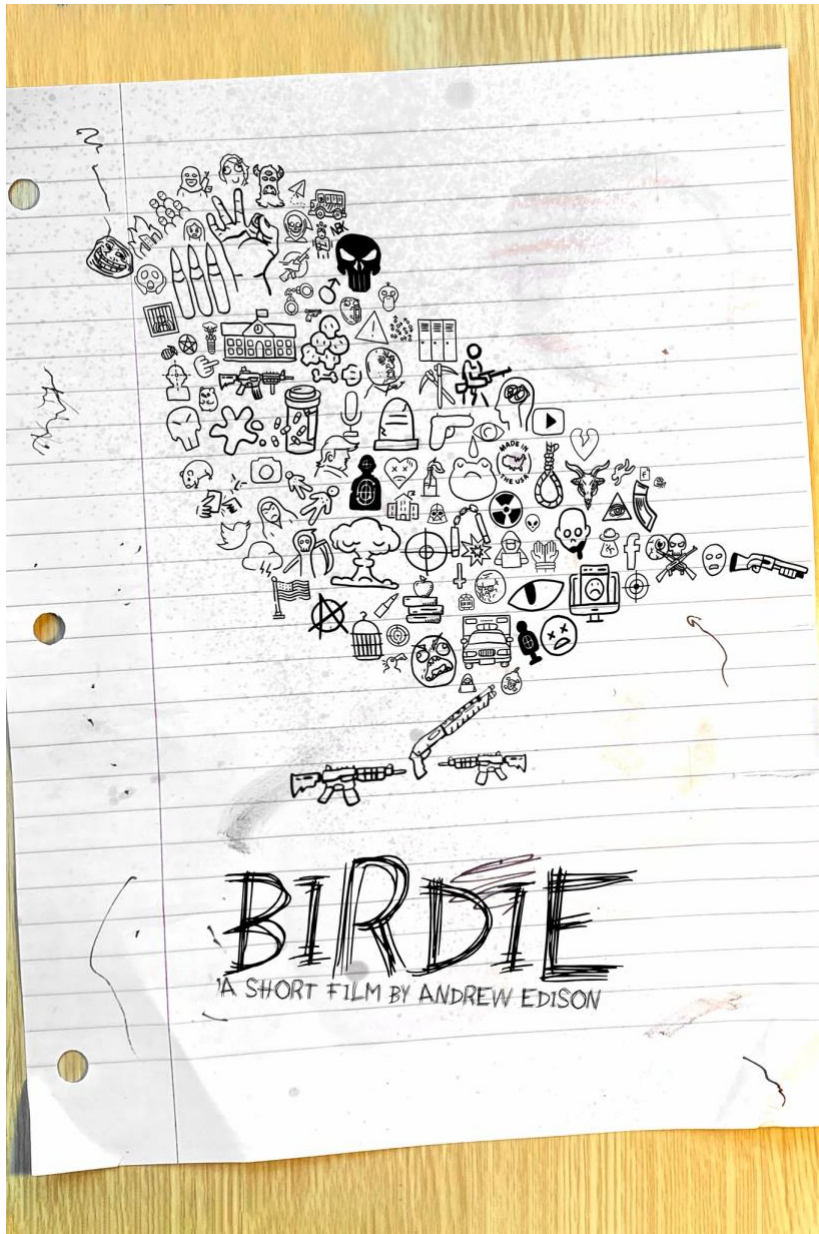
